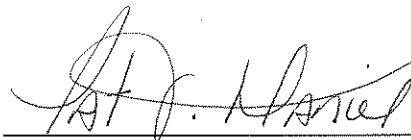


NOTICE OF SPECIAL EMERGENCY ITEM
OF THE
CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HOUSTON

Because of the potential for loss of life and property to people and communities of the City of Houston resulting from the introduction, transmission, or spread (or imminent threat of the same) of "coronavirus disease 2019" (also known as COVID-19), an emergency, urgent public necessity, and imminent threat to public health and safety exists requiring immediate action of the City Council of the City of Houston. Pursuant to Government Code, Sections 551.041 and 551.045, **NOTICE** is hereby given of the following Special Emergency Item to be considered by the City Council of the City of Houston at the City Council meeting to be held **TUESDAY, MARCH 17, 2020**, at 9:00 a.m. in the Council Chamber, Second Floor, City Hall, 901 Bagby, Houston, Texas, for the purpose of considering the following:

ORDINANCE authorizing the Mayor of Houston to extend or continue a proclamation of a local state of disaster due to a public health disaster for the City of Houston beyond the seven-day period after the proclamation was issued; making certain findings related thereto; providing for severability; and declaring an emergency.

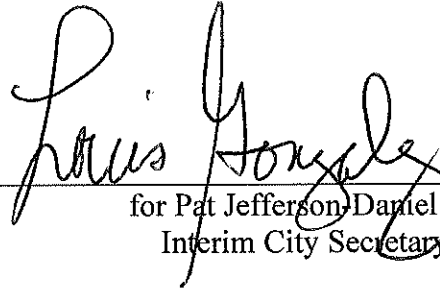
