AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2017-0949 (PASSED ON DECEMBER 5, 2017, AND AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2017-0080 OF FEBRUARY 5, 2017) TO INCREASE THE MAXIMUM CONTRACT AMOUNT FOR A CONTRACT BETWEEN THE CITY OF HOUSTON AND TETRA TECH, INC. FOR DISASTER MANAGEMENT RECOVERY AND CONSULTING SERVICES; DECLARING THE CITY'S INTENT TO SEEK REIMBURSEMENT FROM THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY (FEMA) AND OTHER ELIGIBLE SOURCES FOR SUCH EXPENDITURES; CONTAINING PROVISIONS RELATING TO THE SUBJECT; AND **DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.** 

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HOUSTON, TEXAS:

Section 1. The City Council hereby amends Ordinance No. 2017-0949 to increase the total allocation for the contract, agreement or other undertaking described in the title of this Ordinance from \$37,000,000.00 to \$58,000,000.00.

Section 2. The City Council declares its intent to seek reimbursement for some, or all, of the expenditures of such funds from the Federal Emergency Management Agency ("FEMA") and other eligible sources to the extent allowed by law and hereby authorizes the Mayor to take all actions necessary to secure such reimbursement.

Section 3. There exists a public emergency requiring that this Ordinance be passed finally on the date of its introduction as requested in writing by the Mayor; therefore, this Ordinance shall be passed finally on the date and shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor, however, in the event that the Mayor fails to sign this Ordinance within five days after its passage and adoption, it shall take effect in accordance with Article VI, Section 6, City of Houston Charter.
