City of Houston, Texas Ordinance No. 2020-620

AN ORDINANCE DEAPPROPRIATING THE SUM OF \$1,748,998.08 FROM THE HAS AIRPORTS IMPROVEMENT FUND, APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF \$10,717,935.95 FROM THE HAS RENEWAL AND REPLACEMENT FUND, AND AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2017-0485 TO INCREASE THE MAXIMUM CONTRACT AMOUNT FOR ON-CALL AIRPORT PROFESSIONAL PLANNING CONSULTING SERVICES CONTRACTS WITH HNTB CORPORATION, LEIGHFISHER, INC., AND RICONDO & ASSOCIATES, INC. (PROJECT NOS. 739A, 739B AND 739C); CONTAINING PROVISIONS RELATING TO THE SUBJECT; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HOUSTON, TEXAS:

Section 1. The City Council hereby deappropriates and appropriates the sum or sums of money set out in the title of this Ordinance, out of the respective fund or funds set out in such title.

Section 2. Section 4 of Ordinance No. 2017-0485 is hereby amended to increase the maximum contract amount from \$10,000,000.00 to \$16,500,000.00 The total allocation for the revised contract approved and authorized hereby shall never exceed \$16,500,000.00 unless and until this sum is increased by ordinance of City Council.

Section 3. There exists a public emergency requiring that this Ordinance be passed finally on the date of its introduction as requested in writing by the Mayor; therefore, this Ordinance shall be passed finally on such date and shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; however, in the event that the Mayor fails to sign this Ordinance within five days after its passage and adoption, it shall take effect in accordance with Article VI, Section 6, Houston City Charter.
