AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF \$1,474,600.00 OUT OF THE DEDICATED DRAINAGE AND STREET RENEWAL CAPITAL FUND - DRAINAGE CHARGE; APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING A **AMENDMENT** TO THE PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES CONTRACT BETWEEN THE CITY OF HOUSTON AND KIT PROFESSIONALS, INC. FOR WESTBURY AREA DRAINAGE AND **SUBPROJECT IMPROVEMENTS** (APPROVED 1 PAVING ORDINANCE NO. 2017-0891); PROVIDING FUNDING FOR CIP COST OF **FACILITIES** TO CONSTRUCTION RECOVERY RELATING FINANCED BY THE DEDICATED DRAINAGE AND STREET RENEWAL CAPITAL FUND - DRAINAGE CHARGE; CONTAINING PROVISIONS RELATING TO THE SUBJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Section 1. The City Council hereby appropriates the sum or sums of money set out in the title of this Ordinance, out of the respective fund or funds set out in such title as follows: the sum of \$1,340,545.00 is appropriated for contract services related to the project described in the title, and the sum of \$134,055.00 is appropriated for CIP Cost Recovery relating to construction of facilities financed by the fund described in such title.

Section 2. The City Council hereby approves and authorizes this First Amendment as described in the title of this Ordinance, in substantially the form as shown in the document which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference. The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute such document and all related documents on behalf of the City of Houston. The City Secretary is hereby authorized to attest to all such signatures and to affix the seal of the City to all such documents.

Section 3. The Mayor is hereby authorized to take all actions necessary to effectuate the City's intent and objectives in approving such agreement, agreements or other undertaking described in the title of this ordinance, in the event of changed circumstances.

Section 4. The City Attorney is hereby authorized to take all action necessary to enforce all legal obligations under said contract without further authorization from the City Council.

Section 5. There exists a public emergency requiring that this Ordinance be passed finally on the date of its introduction as requested in writing by the Mayor; therefore, this Ordinance shall be passed finally on such date and shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; however, in the event that the Mayor fails to sign this Ordinance within five days after its passage and adoption, it shall take effect in accordance with Article VI, Section 6, Houston City Charter.

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT FOR PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR DESIGN OF WESTBURY AREA DRAINAGE AND PAVING IMPROVEMENTS ("FIRST AMENDMENT") is made on the counter-signature date by and between the CITY OF HOUSTON, TEXAS (the "City"), a home-rule city of the state of Texas, and KIT PROFESSIONALS, INC. (the "Consultant"), a Texas corporation.

RECITALS:

- Pursuant to Ordinance No. 2017-0891 (November 21, 2017), the City and the Consultant entered into an Agreement for Professional Engineering Services for the Design of Westbury Area Drainage and Paving Improvements (the "Original Agreement").
- 2. The original appropriation covered Phase I Preliminary Design Basic and Additional Services. The City is currently ready to move on to Phase II Final Design and Phase III Construction Phase Services.
- 3. This First Amendment will increase the Limit of Appropriation, to allow for completion of the services provided by the Consultant.
- 4. NOW THEREFORE, the parties agree as follows:

ARTICLE I.

Section 3.4, "Limit of Appropriation," of Article 3, "Duties of the City", of the Original Agreement, is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

3.4 **Limit of Appropriation**. Consultant recognizes that under certain provisions of the Charter of the City of Houston, the City may not obligate itself by contract to an extent in excess of an amount appropriated by the City Council and further recognizes that only **\$1,285,857.00** has been appropriated and budgeted by City Council to pay the Cost of Basic Services hereunder and that only

<u>\$742,873.00</u> has been appropriated and budgeted by the City Council to pay the cost of Additional Services hereunder for a total amount of **\$2,028,730.00**.

ARTICLE II.

Except as modified under this First Amendment, the Original Agreement will remain in full force and effect. In the event of a conflict between the Original Agreement, and this First Amendment, this First Amendment shall prevail.
