City of Houston, Texas Ordinance No. 2020-779

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF A GRANT AWARD FROM THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF FAMILY AND PROTECTIVE SERVICES FOR THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE TEXAS NURSE-FAMILY PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM (THE "GRANT") TO THE CITY OF HOUSTON HEALTH DEPARTMENT; DECLARING THE CITY'S ELIGIBILITY FOR SUCH GRANT; AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF THE CITY OF HOUSTON HEALTH DEPARTMENT ("DIRECTOR") TO ACCEPT AND EXPEND THE GRANT FUNDS, AS

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AWARDED, AND TO APPLY FOR, ACCEPT AND EXPEND ALL SUBSEQUENT GRANT AWARDS, IF ANY, PERTAINING TO THE GRANT; CONTAINING PROVISIONS RELATING TO THE SUBJECT; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HOUSTON, TEXAS:

Section 1. That the City Council authorizes the acceptance of the Notice of Grant Award in the amount of \$1,736,321.09 from the Texas Department of Family and Protective Services (“DFPS”) to the Houston Health Department for the continued administration of the Texas Nurse-Family Partnership program (the “Grant”), for the funding period from September 1, 2020 through August 31, 2021, as described in the form as attached to this ordinance and incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2. That the City of Houston is certified as eligible to receive this grant assistance from DFPS for the Grant.

Section 3. That the Director of the Houston Health Department (the “Director”) is authorized and directed to represent and act for the City in dealing with DFPS for the purpose of the above Grant program and is authorized to execute such documents and all related documents on behalf of the City of Houston.

Section 4. That the Director is designated as the official authorized to accept and expend the funds, as awarded, for the purpose of this Grant program for the budget period from September 1, 2020 through August 31, 2021, and to apply for and accept all subsequent awards, if any, pertaining to the Grant for subsequent periods not to exceed five years thereafter. The Mayor is hereby authorized, without further City Council action, to execute all related contracts, agreements, amendments, extension or renewal of the contract and documents in connection with the above-mentioned Grant, with the approval as to form by the City Attorney. The Mayor and the Director are authorized to execute all documents accepting current and future grant funds for the above-mentioned periods. The City Secretary is hereby authorized to attest to all such signatures and to affix the seal of the City to all such documents.

Section 5. That the City Council approves the use of the City’s required in-kind matching contributions in the amount of \$308,173.62

Section 6. There exists a public emergency requiring that this Ordinance be passed finally on the date of its introduction as requested in writing by the Mayor; therefore, this Ordinance shall be passed finally on such date and shall take effect immediately upon its passage

and approval by the Mayor; however, in the event that the Mayor fails to sign this Ordinance within five days after its passage and adoption, it shall take effect in accordance with Article VI, Section 6, Houston City Charter.
