

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2018-1037 (PASSED DECEMBER 19, 2018, AND AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2015-0858, PASSED ON SEPTEMBER 9, 2015) TO INCREASE THE MAXIMUM CONTRACT AMOUNT TO \$47,992,404.60 FOR THE CONTRACT BETWEEN THE CITY OF HOUSTON AND TDINDUSTRIES, INC. FOR FACILITY OPERATIONS, MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR SERVICES FOR VARIOUS DEPARTMENTS; CONTAINING PROVISIONS RELATING TO THE SUBJECT; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HOUSTON, TEXAS:

Section 1. The City Council hereby amends Ordinance No. 2018-1037 to increase the total allocation for the contract, agreement or other undertaking described in the title of this Ordinance from \$42,850,361.25 to \$47,992,404.60.

Section 2. There exists a public emergency requiring that this Ordinance be passed finally on the date of its introduction as requested in writing by the Mayor; therefore, this Ordinance shall be passed finally on such date and shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; however, in the event that the Mayor fails to sign this Ordinance within five days after its passage and adoption, it shall take effect in accordance with Article VI, Section 6, Houston City Charter.
