City of Houston, Texas Ordinance No. 2020-844

A AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF THE MAYOR'S OFFICE OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND HOMELAND SECURITY TO ELECTRONICALLY SUBMIT APPLICATIONS FOR SUBRECIPIENT GRANT ASSISTANCE AND EXECUTE AND ACCEPT SUBRECIPIENT GRANT AGREEMENTS WITH THE STATE OF TEXAS OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR RELATING TO THE FY2020 HOMELAND SECURITY GRANT PROGRAM FUNDING FROM THE URBAN AREA SECURITY INITIATIVE AND THE STATE HOMELAND SECURITY PROGRAM; DECLARING THE CITY'S ELIGIBILITY FOR SUCH GRANTS; AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR TO ACT AS THE CITY'S REPRESENTATIVE IN THE APPLICATION PROCESS, TO REQUEST AND/OR ACCEPT THE GRANTS AND MANAGE AND

EXPEND THE GRANT FUNDS AS AWARDED, AND TO APPLY FOR AND ACCEPT ALL SUBSEQUENT AWARDS, IF ANY, PERTAINING TO THE PROGRAM INCLUDING AMENDMENTS OR MODIFICATIONS TO THESE AGREEMENTS OR ANY SUBSEQUENT DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO SECURE THE CITY'S GRANT FUNDING; CONTAINING PROVISIONS RELATING TO THE SUBJECT; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HOUSTON, TEXAS:

Section 1. That the City of Houston is eligible to receive these grants pursuant to the Homeland Security Appropriations Act, as amended from time to time, and the eligibility rules of the State of Texas Office of the Governor.

Section 2. That the Director of the Mayor's Office of Public Safety and Homeland Security ("Director") is authorized and directed to represent and act for the City in dealing with the State of Texas Office of the Governor, Homeland Security Grants Division to make electronic applications to apply for, to electronically accept and to manage grant awards (including amendments/modifications to the awards) or any subsequent agreements necessary to secure Houston's allocations through the Homeland Security Grant Program which includes 24 Sub-awards in the Urban Area Security Initiative and four Sub-awards in the State Homeland Security Program which are hereby incorporated by reference in Exhibit "A":

Urban Area Security Initiative for \$9,929,391.00

State Homeland Security Program for \$398,970.12

IN THE EVENT OF LOSS OR MISUSE OF OFFICE OF GOVERNOR FUNDS, THE CITY COUNCIL ASSURES THAT FUNDS WILL BE RETURNED TO THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR IN FULL.

Section 3. That the Director is designated as the official authorized to electronically accept and execute the grant award documents and all related documents on behalf of the City of Houston and manage and expend the funds for the purpose of this grant assistance program and to apply for and accept all subsequent awards, if any, not to exceed five years, pertaining to the Urban Area Security Initiative and the State Homeland Security Program. The Director is authorized to execute all documents accepting current and future grant funds, if any, through these programs during the life of these grant awards, without further City Council action. The Mayor is hereby authorized, without further City Council action, to execute all related contracts, amendments, agreements and documents, if necessary or required in connection with this grant assistance program with the approval of the City Attorney. The City Secretary is hereby authorized to attest to all such signatures and to affix the seal of the City to all such documents.

Section 4. The Mayor is hereby authorized to take all actions necessary to effectuate the City's intent and objectives in approving such agreements or other undertakings described in the title of this ordinance, in the event of changed circumstances.

Section 5. The City Attorney is hereby authorized to take all action necessary to enforce all legal obligations under said agreements without further authorization from Council.

Section 6. There exists a public emergency requiring that this Ordinance be passed finally on the date of its introduction as requested in writing by the Mayor; therefore, this Ordinance shall be passed finally on such date and shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; however, in the event that the Mayor fails to sign this Ordinance within five days after its passage and adoption, it shall take effect in accordance with Article VI, Section 6, Houston City Charter.
