APPROVE Spending Authority for airport engine parts, overhauls, and repair services from **PRECISION AVIATION, INC.** for the Houston Police Department - 3 years - \$1,724,813.60 - General Fund

Background:

Formal Bids Received September 7, 2023, for S17-N32921 - Approve spending authority in the amount not to exceed \$1,724,813.60 for aircraft engine parts, overhauls, and repair services from Precision Aviation, Inc. for the Houston Police Department.

Specific Explanation:

The Chief of the Houston Police Department and the Chief Procurement Officer recommend that City Council approve spending authority in the amount not to exceed **\$1,724,813.60** for Lycoming aircraft engine parts, overhauls, and repair services for the Houston Police Department (HPD). It is further requested that authorization be given to issue purchase orders, as needed, for a **36-month period** to **Precision Aviation, Inc.** This award covers engine parts, overhauls, and repair services for Lycoming aircraft engines and components.

The project was advertised in accordance with the State of Texas bid laws. Five prospective bidders downloaded the solicitation document from SPD's e-bidding website and two bids were received as outlined below.
