Ordinance Approving Tetra Tech, Inc. Debris Monitoring Contract Amendment

Houston Public Works (HPW) respectfully requests Council approval of the subject item on November 6, 2024.

The current contract expires on November 10, 2024. HPW requested an amendment in July to continue monitoring services of silt removal in Lake Houston, which is funded with a Hurricane Harvey disaster recovery grant from FEMA. Monitoring of the silt removal is required for grant compliance.

A 90-day extension to November 10, 2024 was executed. However, ongoing debris monitoring services are necessary, as work is still being performed on Hurricane Harvey debris projects as well as monitoring services for Lake Houston and various dredging activities to be funded by FEMA and the Texas Water Development Board. This amendment will extend the term of the contract to allow this work to continue. There is sufficient funding remaining on this contract to sustain the department through the end of the amended term.
