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**SPECIFIC DESCRIPTION:** The General Services Department recommends that City Council appropriate \$67,130.91 to the existing citywide contract with Kentech, Inc. to furnish and install an emergency generator to replace the damaged emergency generator and to provide standby power for the Central Library.

**PROJECT LOCATION:** 500 McKinney Street (493L)

**PREVIOUS HISTORY AND PROJECT SCOPE:** On February 12, 2014, Ordinance No. 2014-99, City Council awarded a three-year contract, with two one-year options to Kentech, Inc., in an amount not to exceed \$1,278,914.50 for maintenance, repair and testing of emergency power units for various departments. The contract is funded through various appropriations/ allocations for emergency system maintenance, repair and testing services. To date, \$240,291.00 has been expended on the contract.

**M/WBE INFORMATION:** The contract was awarded with an 11% M/WBE goal. Currently, Kentech, Inc. has achieved 48.3% M/WBE participation.
