SPECIFIC DESCRIPTION: The General Services Department recommends that City Council appropriate \$66,720.00 to the existing citywide contract with TDIndustries, Inc. to furnish and install a chiller to replace the temporary chiller at the Collier Neighborhood Library.

PROJECT LOCATION: 6200 Pinemont Dr. 77092 (451F)

PREVIOUS HISTORY AND PROJECT SCOPE: On September 9, 2015, Ordinance No. 2015-0858, City Council awarded a five-year contract with two one-year options to renew to TDIndustries Inc., in an amount not to exceed \$34,280,289.00 for facilities maintenance services for the General Services Department. The contract is funded through various appropriations/allocations for maintenance and repair services on heating, ventilation and airconditioning (HVAC), building automation, plumbing, lighting and electrical power supply systems. To date, \$4,559,596.56 has been expended on the contract.

M/WBE INFORMATION: A 15% M/WBE goal has been established for this contract. Currently, TDIndustries has achieved 45.67% M/WBE participation.
