The appropriation of \$109,310,966.07 results from tax increment revenues received in Tax Year 2015 by the City for various TIRZs. As set forth in the attached spreadsheet, \$1,669,701.96 will be transferred to the City's Affordable Housing Fund pursuant to the City's Tri-Party Agreements with the TIRZs and their redevelopment authorities; \$5,591,689.08 will be transferred to the General Fund for TIRZ administrative costs; and \$102,049,575.03 will be paid to the various redevelopment authorities on behalf of the TIRZ or retained in the TIRZ Fund for approved project costs.
