RECOMMENDATION: Approve a motion providing for two public hearing dates to determine whether to continue the Juvenile Curfew Ordinance (Sections 28-171 – 28-175, City Code of Ordinances).

Amount and Source of Funding: N/A

SPECIFIC EXPLANATION:

State law requires cities that have adopted a juvenile curfew ordinance to conduct hearings every three years to determine whether to abolish, continue, or modify the curfew restrictions. City Council last acted to continue the current City of Houston Juvenile Curfew Ordinance (Sections 28-171 – 28-175, City Code of Ordinances) in April 2013. To allow for public input and in accordance with state statute (Section 370.002 of the Texas Local Government Code), two public hearings are required to be held before City Council. The public hearing dates are June 22, 2016 and June 29, 2016.

Please note that on June 14, 2016, a report on this issue will be presented to the Public Safety and Homeland Security (PSHS) Committee by the HPD's Juvenile Division.
