City of Houston, Texas Ordinance No. 2014-941

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 2011-998 TO INCREASE THE MAXIMUM CONTRACT AMOUNT FOR A CONTRACT BETWEEN THE CITY AND MUNISERVICES, LLC FOR SALES/USE TAX AUDIT AND SALES/USE TAX ANALYSIS AND REPORTING SERVICES; CONTAINING PROVISIONS RELATING TO THE SUBJECT; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HOUSTON, TEXAS:

Section 1. Section 4 of Ordinance Number 2011-998 is hereby amended as follows:

The revised total allocation for the contract, agreement or other undertaking approved and authorized hereby shall never exceed **\$2,350,000.00** which amount represents an increase of **\$1,500,000.00**, unless and until this sum is further increased by ordinance of City Council.

Section 2. There exists a public emergency requiring that this Ordinance be passed finally on the date of its introduction as requested in writing by the Mayor; therefore, this Ordinance shall be passed finally on such date and shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; however, in the event that the Mayor fails to sign this Ordinance within five days after its passage and adoption, it shall take effect in accordance with Article VI, Section 6, Houston City Charter.
