

City of Houston Ordinance No. _____

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING A PAYMENT OF \$21,765.53 TO RESICOM, INC. UNDER A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT WITH THE CITY FOR SAFE SIDEWALK PROJECT ORIGINALLY AUTHORIZED BY ORDINANCE NO. 2011-0814; CONTAINING OTHER PROVISIONS RELATING TO THE SUBJECT; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HOUSTON, TEXAS:

Section 1. That, upon the recommendation of the Director of the Public Works Department, the City Council approves the payment of **\$21,765.53** to **RESICOM, INC.** for WBS No. N-00610A-0119-4 under the contract identified in the caption of this ordinance.

Section 2. That nothing in this ordinance shall be deemed to be an acceptance of work or a waiver of any claims the City may have under the construction contract with **RESICOM, INC.**

Section 3. That there exists a public emergency requiring that this Ordinance be passed finally on the date of its introduction as requested in writing by the Mayor; therefore, this Ordinance shall be passed finally on such date and shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; however, in the event that the Mayor fails to sign this Ordinance within five days after its passage and adoption, it shall take effect in accordance with Article VI, Section 6, Houston City Charter.
