

SPECIFIC EXPLANATION: The Houston Police Department is applying for the FY 2018 Selective Traffic Enforcement Program (STEP) Comprehensive Motor Vehicle Traffic Safety Grant from the Texas Department of Transportation in the amount of \$999,999.49. The grant period becomes effective October 1, 2017 and ends September 30, 2018. The City is required to make a cash match of \$100,000.67 and an in-kind contribution of \$783,754.24. The total cost of the program is \$1,883,754.40. The grant funding will be used to provide overtime for personnel over the next 12 months to enforce DWI violations, speeding, occupant protection, as well as violations occurring at intersections. The City's in-kind contribution consists of fringe benefits and court costs of operational personnel. Funding for this item is included in the FY2018 Adopted Budget; therefore, no Fiscal Note is required as stated in the Financial Policy Ordinance No. 2014-1078.
