 The Administration has undertaken a comprehensive review of the proposed FY18 TIRZ budgets and recommends approval of the FY18 Operating Budget for the Fifth Ward Redevelopment Authority (Authority) and the FY18 – FY22 CIP Budget for Tax Increment Reinvestment Zone Number Eighteen (Zone). Total Operating Budget for FY18 is \$8,605,421 which includes \$514,274 for required fund transfers and \$8,091,147 for Project Costs. The FY18 Operating Budget includes \$7,243,047 in Developer Reimbursements primarily funded by the General Land Office (GLO). The FY18 – FY22 CIP Budget for the Zone totals \$2,013,500 for affordable housing (land acquisition, design, and construction), sidewalks, cultural facilities, historic preservation and community parks. The FY18 Operating Budget includes \$633,500 for capital expenditures and \$92,800 for administration and overhead. The FY18 Budget provides for the transfer of \$152,723 to the City's Housing and Community Development Department for Affordable Housing. The Authority must advise the Chief Development Officer of any budget amendments. Adjustments to the budget that exceed the lesser of \$400,000 or 5% of Project Costs require City Council approval.
