 Settlement approval is requested for this matter, which involves an automobile accident that occurred on				
November 8, 2011, at the intersection of Rosehaven and Chimira. At the time of the accident, Chimira				
Street normally had stop signs on the east and west of the intersection. The sign for the eastbound traffic				
was missing. Frederick Tippett-Crenshaw, another defendant, was travelling east on Chimira and collided with vehicle driven by Cruise, the plaintiff, allegedly due to the missing stop sign.
