SUBJECT: Contract Award for Fire Hydrant Replacement Project

RECOMMENDATION: (Summary)

Accept low bid, award construction Contract and appropriate funds.

PROJECT NOTICE/JUSTIFICATION: This project is required to replace damaged or irreparable fire hydrants throughout the City.

<u>DESCRIPTION/SCOPE</u>: Work shall include the replacement of fire hydrants and valves, the height correction of fire hydrants, the relocation of fire hydrants and ancillary work. The contract duration for this project is 365 calendar days. This is an on-call contract with projects assigned on an as-needed basis.

**LOCATION:** The project area is generally bounded by the City Limits.

BIDS: Bids for this project were received on November 30, 2017. The Seven (7) bids are as follows:
