Background:

SUBJECT: Petition for the City's consent to the addition of two (2) tracts of land totaling 35.8287 acres to West Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 2 (Key Map No. 445Q & 445U).

RECOMMENDATION: Petition for the City's consent to the addition of two (2) tracts of land totaling 35.8287 acres to West Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 2 be approved.

SPECIFIC EXPLANATION: West Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 2 (the "District") was created through the TCEQ in 1975, and currently consists of 532.8946 acres within Harris County. The District is within the extraterritorial jurisdiction of the City and has petitioned the City for consent to add 35.8287 acres of mixed land. The developed land consists of a single residential house and the vacant land is proposed to be developed as multi-family residential properties, to the District. The proposed annexation tracts are located in the vicinity of Franz Road, SH-99, Morton Ranch Road, and John Crump Lane. The addition of land to the District does not release it from the City's extraterritorial jurisdiction.

The Utility District Review Committee has evaluated the application with respect to wastewater collection and treatment, potable water distribution, storm water conveyance, and other public services.

The District has a wastewater collection system and treatment facility. The annexation tracts will be provided with wastewater treatment by the Williamsburg Regional Sewage Authority. This regional plant also provides wastewater treatment to Harris County Municipal No. 61, which also serves Harris County Municipal No. 62, Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 63, Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 64, Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 65, and West Harris County Municipal District No. 5. Potable water is provided by the District.

The nearest major drainage facility for West Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 2 is Mason Creek, which flows into Buffalo Bayou, and finally into the Houston Ship Channel. The proposed annexation tracts are not within the 100 or 500 year floodplain.

By executing the Petition for Consent, the District has acknowledged that all plans for the construction of water conveyance, wastewater collection, and storm water collection systems within the district must be approved by the City of Houston prior to their construction.

The Utility District Review Committee recommends that the subject petition be approved.
