Background:

SUBJECT: Petition for the City's consent to the addition of 1.033 acres to North Green Municipal Utility District (Key Map No. 373F).

RECOMMENDATION: Petition for the City's consent to the addition of 1.033 acres to North Green Municipal Utility District be approved.

SPECIFIC EXPLANATION: North Green Municipal Utility District (the "District") was created through the TCEQ in 1980, and currently consists of 433.383 acres within Harris County. The District is within the extraterritorial jurisdiction of the City and has petitioned the City for consent to add 1.033 acres of developed commercial land, a gas station and retail center, to the District. The proposed annexation tract is located in the vicinity of Regional Park Drive, Imperial Valley Drive, Rankin Road, and Chisholm Trail. The addition of land to the District does not release it from the City's extraterritorial jurisdiction.

The Utility District Review Committee has evaluated the application with respect to wastewater collection and treatment, potable water distribution, storm water conveyance, and other public services.

The District has a wastewater collection system and treatment facility. The annexation tract will be provided with wastewater treatment by the North Green Municipal Utility District Wastewater Treatment Facility. Potable water is provided by the District.

The nearest major drainage facility for the District is Upper Greens Bayou, which flows into the Houston Ship Channel. The proposed annexation tract is not within the 100 or 500 year floodplain.

By executing the Petition for Consent, the District has acknowledged that all plans for the construction of water conveyance, wastewater collection, and storm water collection systems within the District must be approved by the City of Houston prior to their construction.

The Utility District Review Committee recommends that the subject petition be approved.
