

City Council Chamber, City Hall, Tuesday, November 4, 2014

A Regular Meeting of the Houston City Council was held at 1:30 p.m. Tuesday, November 4, 2014, with Mayor Annise Parker presiding with Council Members Brenda Stardig, Jerry Davis, Ellen R. Cohen, Dwight Boykins, Dave Martin, Richard Nguyen, Oliver Pennington, Edward Gonzalez, Robert Gallegos, Mike Laster, Larry V. Green, Stephen C. Costello, David Robinson, Michael Kubosh, and C. O. "Brad" Bradford, Jack Christie D.C., Mr. Harlan Heilman, City Attorney, Division Chief, Claims & Subrogation Division; and Ms. Marta Crinejo, Agenda Director and Ms. Stella Ortega, Agenda Office, present.

At 1:43 p.m. Mayor Parker called the meeting to order and stated they would start with the presentation portion of the City Council meeting, and recognized Council Member Davis for the first presentation.

Council Member Bradford stated that this was a special time for the Sam Houston Boy Scouts and are present in the chamber today, they are celebrating their 100th birthday this particular year and month; on November 13, 2014 they are going to do a community service day which they are going to do 100,000 hours of service in one day and he wanted to thank the scout leaders, the parents, and the scouts themselves.
